HORSE FAN BADGE

- ❖ STABLE TOUR - What is involved in the everyday care of a horse? We will discuss feeding, treats, exercise, housing, and shoeing. (Badge req. #2)
- ❖ TACK - Learn the basic parts of the saddle and the bridle, and how to care for riding equipment. (Badge req. #7)
- ❖ RIDING ATTIRE - What do we wear when we ride, and why? What safety equipment is necessary, for the rider and the horse? (Badge req. #3)
- ❖ OLYMPIC FREESTYLE - Video presentation of the world's best riders in competition. (Badge req. #10)
- ❖ HORSES THROUGH HISTORY - How have horses evolved, from prehistoric times to current breeds and their uses? Learn the correct names of the horse's unique anatomy. (Badge req. #4)
- ❖ CAREERS WITH HORSES - What does it take to become a veterinarian, a horse trainer, a riding instructor, or a Farrier? (Badge req. #6)

Badge work will require approximately 2-2 ½ hours to complete.
